

# November Block of the Month 2007

## Three Dimensional Double Pinwheel

9" finished or 9½" raw edged

**Colors** - background- light fabric  
Green fabric for large triangles  
Red for small triangles

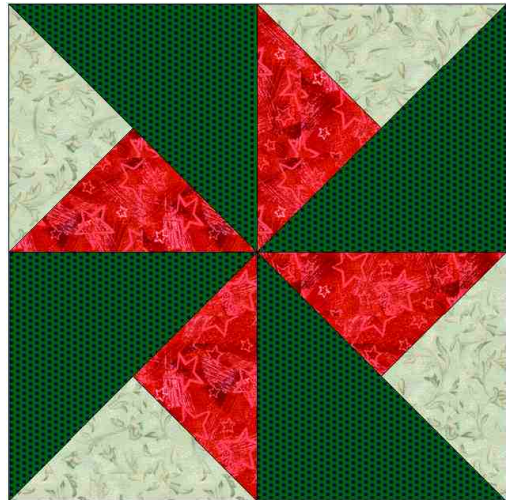
### Cut:

Background - light fabric: 2 @ 5 3/8" squares

Green: 2 @ 5 3/8" squares

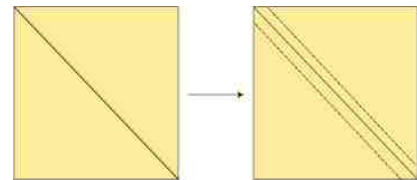
Red: 4 @ 4 ½" squares

**Fold:** Fold the red 4 ½" squares in half diagonally. Press. Take each triangle and fold in half again and press again. You should now have a triangle with all the raw edges on the long side. Pin to stabilize and set aside.



### Sew:

Layer both background and green 5 3/8" squares face to face. Mark a diagonal line on background fabric, corner to corner. Sew 1/4" on each side of the marked line. Cut in half on the marked line. Press to the darker fabric.



**Assemble:** Layout fabric half squares as above, pin red folded triangles raw edges to outside edge of light background in sewn half square (as shown in block picture) and sew.
