

September Block of the Month 2007

2 Maple Leaf blocks
9" finished or 9½" raw edged

Colorways:

Each square a different fall leaf color
medium to darker beige = background
brown = stem

Cut:

- 6 - 3½" squares of leaf
- 4 - 3 7/8" squares of leaf
- 4 - 3 7/8" squares of background
- 4 - 3½" squares of background
- 2 - 1 1/4 " x 5 ½ " of stems

SEW:

1. Cut 2 of the 3½" background squares in half, corner to corner. Sew in stem fabric. Trim down to 3 ½" square. (Figure 2)
2. Layer 3 7/8" squares of leaf and background, right sides together. Mark a diagonal line on background fabric, corner to corner. Sew 1/4" on each side of the marked line. (Figure 3)
3. Cut in half on the marked line. Press to the darker side. Trim corners. (Figure 4)
4. Layout fabric blocks as in Figure 1 and sew.

Possible Settings:

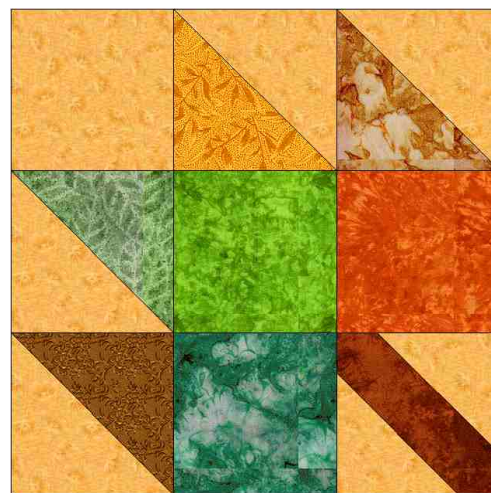

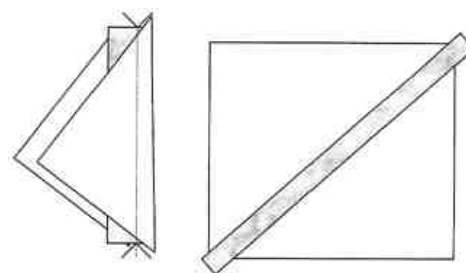

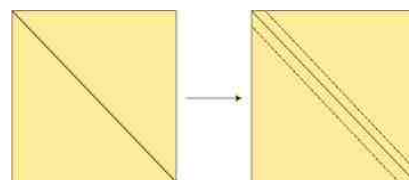
