

Printing tip: Go to File, Print. On the Print box make sure Scale to Page is set at :No Scaling.

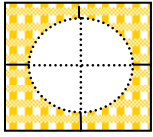
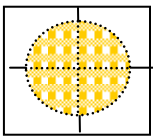
## April BOM Easy Drunkard's Path

- |   |   |   |   |

| 1 | 8½" square of white-on-white fabric     | 1 | 6½" square of white-on-white fabric     |
| 1 | 8½" square of 1930's reproduction print | 1 | 6½" square of 1930's reproduction print |
| 4 | 7" squares of freezer paper             |   |   |

Cut out the 6" circle below on the outer line and trace around it 2 times on the non-waxed side of the freezer paper. Cut out the 6" circles of freezer paper. Cut on the inner circle line. Trace the 5½" circle on the non-waxed side of freezer paper twice.

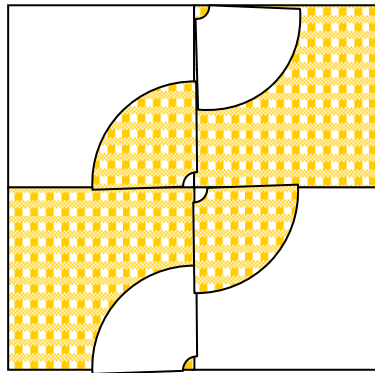
Iron a 6" freezer paper circle on the wrong-side of the 6½" squares of fabric (white-on-white and 1930's). Cut around the edge of the freezer paper template. Remove the freezer paper.

Pin a 5½" freezer paper circle on the wrong-side of the fabric circle. The non-waxed side of the freezer paper should be against the fabric. Gently press the edges of the fabric to the back over the freezer paper templates. Press one spot in each quarter first to hold in place then come back and press in between until all the edge is pressed down. Finger press the fabric circles in quarters and mark creases with a pin.



Press the 8½" squares of fabric into quarters. Pin the fabric circles on the fabric squares matching the pressing marks to center circle. Put the 1930's circle on the white square and put the white circle on the 1930's square. Press and pin in place. With a coordinating thread color sew around the circle with a very narrow zigzag stitch.

Cut blocks into quarters on the pressed lines. Remove freezer paper and trim excess backing from under circle appliqué leaving a ¼" seam.



Put 2 quarters from each square together as shown and sew together to make 1 block. There will be 2 blocks.
