

Block of the Month—November Christmas Star 9”

- 2 4” squares of green Christmas fabric (metallic preferable)
- 4 4” squares of white/off-white Christmas fabric
- 2 4” squares & 1 3 ½” square of red Christmas fabric (metallic preferable)

With right sides together pair up a green and a white square. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the white square. Sew ¼” on both sides of the diagonal line. **Make 2.** Cut apart on diagonal line and press seams open. Trim to 3 ½” square.

With right sides together pair up a red and a white square. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the white square. Sew ¼” on both sides of the diagonal line. **Make 2.** Cut apart on diagonal line and press seams open. Trim to 3 ½” square.

Lay units out in rows according to diagram below, and sew together. Press seams open. Sew rows together. Block will be 9 ½” unfinished and 9” finished.
