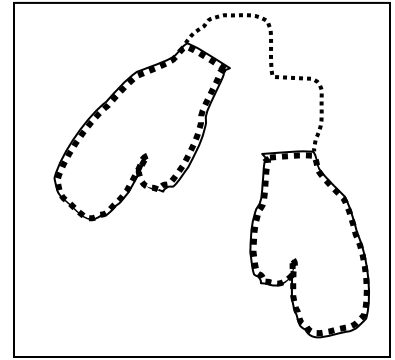


September BOM
Warm Woolen Mittens



8½" x 8½" square of light mottle or tonal flannel for background
6" x 9" rectangle of plaid flannel for mittens
9"-- 12" ribbon, cord or yarn for mitten strings
Small piece of lightweight interfacing or used dryer sheets

Trace mitten patterns on the interfacing with a fine line waterproof marker. Place interfacing on the right side of the plaid flannel. Sew on the drawn line with a short stitch length. Trim around mittens leaving a scant ¼" seam allowance. Clip V shaped notches almost to seam on curves and at thumb point. Clip corners on the diagonal to reduce bulk.

Slit the interfacing down the center for about 2" to 3". Turn inside out and press well. Trim interfacing off leaving a small seam allowance.

Arrange mittens in a pleasing arrangement on the square and pin in place. Attach the mitten strings to mitten cuff, tucking raw edges of string under mittens. Hand or machine blanket-stitch mittens in place using black thread/embroidery floss.
