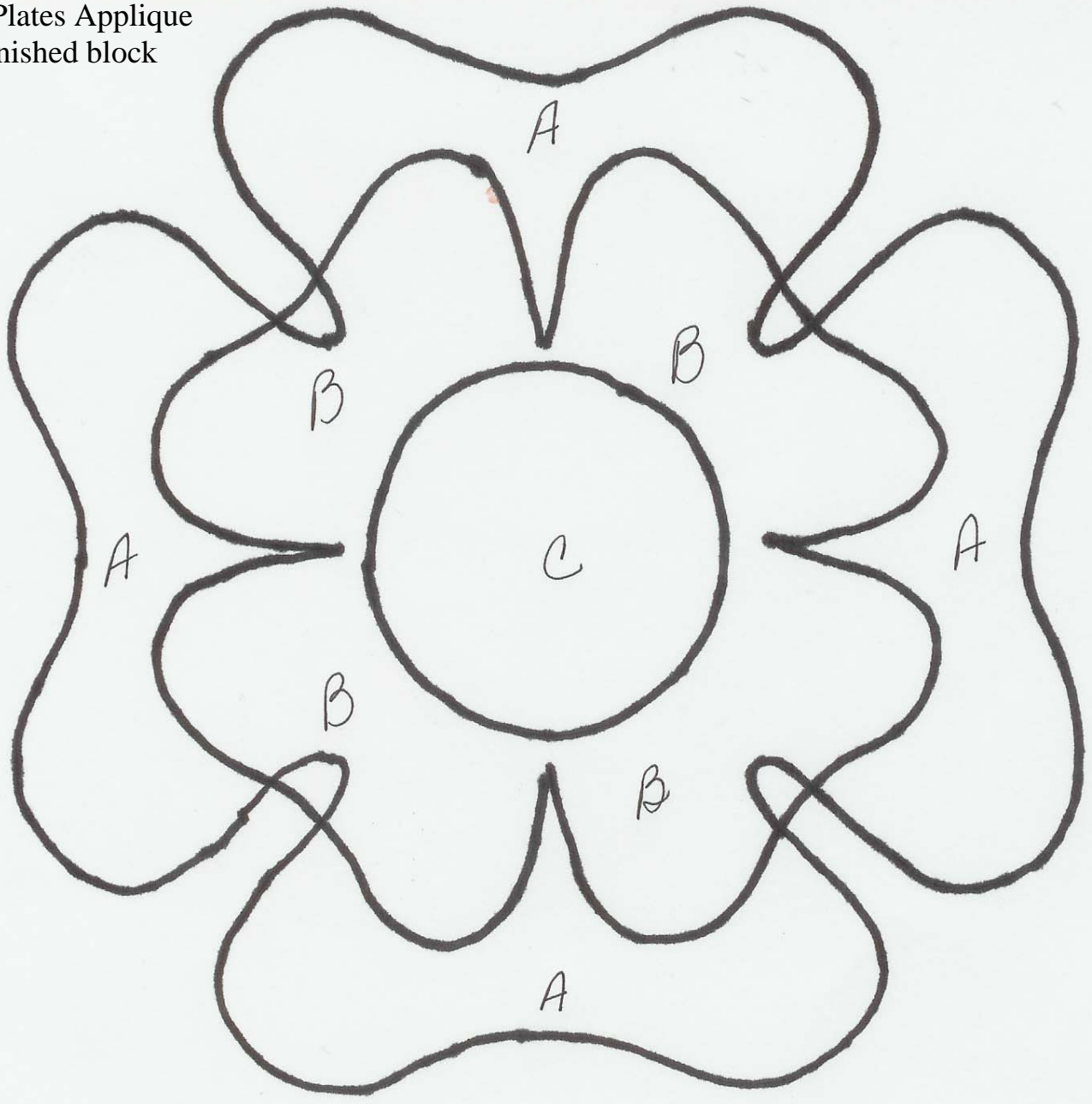


April 2010 BOM
 Dresden Plates Applique
 8" x 8" finished block



This is a Sunshine/Shadows block. It can be made with either a light background or a dark background-your choice. Instructions are written for a light background and dark flower. If you chose to do a dark background block just reverse the color values on the flower sections: background dark, flower A & C light/med flower B dark.

| Background | 9" x 9" " | white with medium/light blue print (reads light value) |
| Flower A: | 7½" x 7½" | dark blue/navy with white print |
| Flower C: | 2½" x 2½" | dark blue/navy with white print |
| Flower B: | 5" x 5" | white with medium/dark/navy blue print (reads medium value) |

Trace A, B & C shapes onto paper side of paper-backed fusible web. Leave at least 1" space between shapes. Cut out leaving about a ½" margin beyond traced lines. Cut out center of design about ½" inside drawn line. You will have a 1" wide "donut" of the pattern. Following manufacture's directions, fuse to the wrong side of appropriate fabric. Cut on marked lines.

Finger-press white background in half in both directions to find center. Center appliques in alpha order on background square. Fuse in place. Using blue thread to match, blanket stitch or zigzag stitch around appliqué edges.

Square up block to 8½" x 8½"
