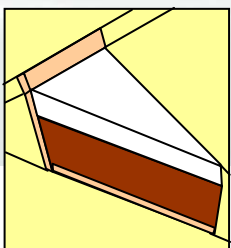


- 5" x 8" piece of pie-filling fabric (fruit or cream)
- Scraps of tan fabric for pie crust edges and bottom
- 6" x 3" tan fabric for pie crust top on fruit pie OR white/cream tone-on-tone for meringue on cream pie
- 1/8 yd. medium/light mottled fabric for background

Pattern should measure 7" x 7". Cut pattern apart on line separating section 1 from section 2. **Add 1/4" seam allowance around outside edges of patterns. Add more is if pattern isn't 7" x 7".**



Sew according to pictures at left for a fruit pie or a cream pie. Sew section 1 to section 2.

Note: piece 2 in section 2 can be made narrow (for fruit-pie crust) or wide (for meringue), correspondingly section 3 is different heights, depending if you make a fruit pie (wider) or cream pie (shorter) be sure to make them the correct width for the pie you are making. Square up block to 7 1/2" x 7 1/2"
