## MAY 2022 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

## Mrs. Hardy's Hanging Basket, 12 1/2" Unfinished

Fabrics: Brown Print --- Basket (A, F) -- Cut: 1 - A 8 7/8" square, cut on diagonal (will use only 1 piece)

1-F 27/8" square, cut on diagonal (will use both pieces)

Flower Print --- Flower (B) -- Cut: 1 - B 6 7/8" square, cut on diagonal (will use only 1 piece)

Black solid or --- Chain (C1) -- Cut: 3 - C1 11/2" square looks like solid Chain (D1) -- Cut: 6 - D1 2" squares

looks like solid Chain (D1) -- Cut: 6-D1 2" squares

Cream 1 --- Chain (D2) -- Cut: 6 - D2 2" squares

Chain (D2) -- Cut: 1 - D2 17/8", then cut on diagonal

Cream 2 -- Chain (C2) -- Cut: 2 - C2 1 1/2" squares

Borders (G, E, H) - Cut: 2 - E 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

2 – G 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles

1 – H 47/8" square, cut on diagonal (will use only 1 piece)

Now that you have it cut out, let's get started! Make 2 D-units: Take the 6 D1 2" squares and 6 D2 2 "squares and make 12 half-triangles, square up to 1 ½". Sew 6 of the D1/D2 half-triangles together as shown, making 2 sets.

On the end of each D1/D2 unit, sew half of the **D2** (1 7/8" square). Watch that you turn the triangles correctly. Sew 1 **C1** square to the other end of one unit as shown. Sew the 2 D1/D2 units to **B** as shown in diagram.

Take **2 C1** and **2 C2** and make a 4-square. Sew **1 F** triangle on the ends of the **E** pieces. See diagram for proper placement. Now assembly as shown in diagram. B unit to A. EF units to sides of AB unit. H to F. C1/C2 square to end of one G, and finally G to AB, G/C1/C2 to AB unit. Beautiful!! So Spring-like!!
