## BLOCK OF MONTH - NOVEMBER 2022

Piece of Pie – Paper Pieced

7 1/2" Finished

Since the pattern takes almost a full page, we are putting it separate from the instructions. You can make either a fruit pie or a cream pie with meringue!

Make copy of pattern. Pattern copy should measure same as in newsletter.

Fabrics: pie-filling fabric (fruit or cream)

Tan for pie crust edges and bottom

Tan for pie crust top on fruit pie OR white/cream tone-on-tone for meringue on cream pie

Background: medium/light mottled fabric, any color

Solid lines and small dotted lines are sewing lines. Outside large dashed lines are cutting (trim) lines.

Sew Section 1 and Section 2 according to pictures below for a fruit pie or a cream pie.

NOTE: piece 2a is made narrower (for fruit-pie crust) and piece 2b is made wider (for meringue)

Correspondingly, piece 3a is wider (for fruit pie filling) and piece 3b is shorter (for cream pie filling.)

Sew Section 1 to Section 2. Remove the paper on both side of this seam allowance. Press seam open.

DO NOT REMOVE ANY OTHER PAPER.

TIP: baste across the outside corners of block (within the seam allowance) before trimming block on the outside large dashed lines.

Trim block on the outside large dashed lines. Unfinished block measures 8" x 8"
