### **QUILT ALASKA 2024**

We want you to enter Quilt Alaska! You are eligible to submit an entry if you are a CFQG member or a resident of Interior Alaska, Doyon Region. The quilt show hangs in the Bear Gallery at Pioneer Park, and is one of the most attended each year.

Works include quilts of any size and wearable art garments. If you are unsure whether your item will qualify for the show, please ask. You are allowed one entry per person, or one garment <u>and</u> one quilt.

Please attach Velcro (hook side) across the entire top of the quilt for hanging. Very large quilts will require additional Velcro on the bottom corners. If your quilt does not lay flat, additional Velcro on the sides will give it a more polished look. If you submit a garment, please try to bring a fixture for display. You can sell your work; however, FAA will retain a 35% commission.



New this year! You will be asked to submit your photo online with your entry form, but you may not have this yet if it's not finished, and that's okay. Also, this year they are asking for your personal photo digitally, and they will print it out for you. No need to bring that with you on entry day. The entry form is available on-line at Fairbanks Arts Association (<a href="https://form.jotform.com/241067962509159">https://form.jotform.com/241067962509159</a>) and must be completed by **Friday, May 31**. Your piece does not need to be completed at the time you submit the form. If you need assistance submitting the form, please contact Jeanne at the number below.

### Sunday, June 30 – I lam to 3pm

Entry day! Bring your quilt to Bear Gallery. You'll be able to drive up to the side door and use the elevator if you arrive early. The Pioneer Park gate will be locked at noon, so you must be out of the park before then. Your quilt or garment must remain on display throughout the entire show.

### Friday, July 5 - 5pm to 7pm

We will be hosting an opening reception for the show. If you can, please bring some small finger food like cookies and appetizers to the gallery at 4:30. Please bring treats that are not messy or that stain easily. i.e. Sugar cookie, yes – blueberry crumble, no!

### Sunday, July 28 – 10am – noon

Pickup day at Bear Gallery.

### **BRIGHT FLORAL 9 PATCH**

Don't miss this easy and versatile Block of the Month. Kathy is still having computer troubles, so the sample photo is from the web, NOT showing the requested fabric colors. Put the bright flowers in the place for the orange fabric. Substitute the very light fabric where the photo has green.

#### Fabrics:

A: Bright flowers

B, Very light (white, white on white, muslin, etc.)

### **Cutting:**

A: Cut (5) 3 1/2 inch square bright flowers

B: Cut (4) 3 1/2 Inch square very light

9 in (finished) 9-patch made up of bright flowers.

#### LETTER FROM TANANA VALLEY STATE FAIR

Dear Cabin Fever Quilters Guild,

As the Interim Executive Director for the Tanana Valley State Fair, I had hoped to deliver this message in person, however, I was unable to attend your March meeting. I am writing this letter in the hopes to shed some light and share history of the Quilt Show at the Fair. The Tanana Valley State Fair and the Cabin Fever Quilters Guild have a 40+ year relationship. The Guild has proudly hosted the show in Upper Totem from 1991-2019, 2020 there was no fair and 2021-2023 the show was hosted in the Agricultural Museum, "the Quilt Barn" at fair time.

The Fair Executive Director in 2021 made the management decision to move the show into the Museum, and it has been hosted there for 3 years.

When the fair lost its 2023 E.D. I was asked to return to keep the 2024 fair plans moving ahead until a new E.D. was hired. Upon my return staff, exhibit volunteers, and other committees reviewed past use of all buildings during the fair.

Our evaluation determined it would be in the best interest of ALL to move the Quilt Show back to Upper Totem. That information has been shared with the CFQG at a board meeting and in several email correspondence.

I am writing today to share with YOU so hopefully it will answer some of the questions about why the decision was made. The fair staff is always interested in getting feedback on how we can do a better job and host the best fair possible.

2024 marks the 100<sup>th</sup> birthday of the Fair July 26-August 4. There are many ways your voice can be heard. Please send any feedback, suggestions to: <a href="mailto:director@tvsfa.org">director@tvsfa.org</a>.

### **Small Quilt Auction Guidelines:**

#### Size Range:

No smaller than 8" by 8" No larger than 100" around

Consider other than square shapes, i.e. oval, triangle, etc.

### Fabric:

Preprinted fabric giving the false impression of pieced work is not what we are looking for. Use your creativity when using your printed fabric especially if you are fussy cutting or using parts of the fabric in appliqué.

#### Quilting:

Whole cloth quilting that highlights special quilting, hand quilting, machine quilting as well as tying are all acceptable.

### Quality of Work:

Care must be taken to present QUALITY workmanship. The committee head will assure that all entries are well done and labeled by the quiltmaker.
