









August Block of The Month

August Block of the Month Four Patch Chain





Fabric and Cutting

Here's another easy one for summer! Use **three** fabrics in cream, dark green and medium green. Make sure you have good contrast.

A - 2 1/2" square. (4 dark green and 4 medium green)

B-2 1/2 X 4 1/2" rectangle. (4 cream)

Sewing

Sew your center 4-patch together. Sew two rectangles on either side of the 4-patch. Sew the top and bottom strips as shown. Then sew the block together as pictured. This should end up scrappy!

Finished size is 8 inches, 8 1/2 inches unfinished
