The potholder exchange is a fun way to get those potholders made in anticipation of the Bazaar Season.

If you plan on attending the Quilt Slushy retreat this year.....make your potholder during this event. There will be batting and insul-bright available during the free pineapple potholder class on Monday, March 30th. Make one potholder for the bazaar and one to exchange with a guild member on the night of the potluck. You do not have to participate in the exchange - some members simply donate their potholder to the bazaar. Each year we sell approximately 100 potholders during the Tanana Valley State fair at our bazaar table. However, if you need a new potholder or want a little variety in your collection then this is a great way to grab something new. This is a good way to use those extra blocks from projects or a good way to try out a block pattern that interests you. Another suggestion is to use theme fabric (no piecing involved) - this was quite popular at some bazaars.

Tip: Be sure to use the silver backed heat resistant padding inside. It is available at most local fabric stores.

In addition, is the PARADE OF APRONS. Bring and wear an apron, new OR old to show off to the rest of the group and share an applicable story about the apron.
