

Small Quilt Auction Guidelines:

Size Range:

No smaller than 8" by 8" No larger than 100" around

Consider other than square shapes, i.e. oval, triangle, etc.

Fabric:

Preprinted fabric giving the false impression of pieced work is not what we are looking for. Use your creativity when using your printed fabric especially if you are fussy cutting or using parts of the fabric in appliqué.

Quilting:

Whole cloth quilting that highlights special quilting, hand quilting, machine quilting as well as tying are all acceptable.

Quality of Work:

Care must be taken to present QUALITY workmanship. The committee head will assure that all entries are well done and labeled by the quiltmaker.





Block of the Month

February Block of the Month Floral Churn Dash





Let's make a sweet little Churn Dash block this month, using colors to remind us that Spring is coming!

Fabric and Cutting

This block uses four fabrics. Use a fun floral fabric for the center, with printed pink and green fabrics to contrast. Use white on white - or - white fabric for the background.

A – 2 7/8 squares, cut diagonally into half square triangles (4 white, 4 pink) – or - use your chosen method to make four half square triangle units measuring 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ unfinished.

 $B - 1 \frac{1}{2} X 2 \frac{1}{2} (4 \text{ white, 4 green})$

 $C - 2 \frac{1}{2} X 2 \frac{1}{2} (1 \text{ floral})$

Sewing

Make your half square triangle units, then sew the block together in rows as pictured.

Finished size is 6 inches, 6 ½ inches unfinished

2025 Mystery Quilt

Mystery quilt to work on at home at your own pace. Quilt finishes at 68x68, 40 fat quarters. Big reveal Dec 2025

Mystery Quilt Fabric Requirements

Quilt is 68" x 68".

Fabric Requirements

1 Fat Quarter Bundle - 40-18" x 22"

Background 2½ yards

Accent % yard

Border-2 2 3/8 yard

Binding: 3/8 yard

Backing: 4 1/3 yards

This will be a 6-month MYSTERY QUILT

January - provided fabric requirements

February - Block A - Make 2

March - Block B - Make 2

April - Block C - Make 2

May - Block D - Make 2

June - Block E - Make 1

July - BREAK FOR FAIR

August - provide Quilt Assembly directions

December - The Big Reveal
