

## Quilt Alaska 2026

Get ready for Quilt Alaska 2026! Let's make this event outstanding!

The biennial show, organized by Fairbanks Arts Association (FAA) and the Cabin Fever Quilters Guild (CFQG), is open to residents of Interior Alaska, Doyon Region and CFQG members. Held at the Bear Gallery within Pioneer Park, it features quilts of any size and wearable art garments, attracting many visitors during the bi-annual event. Each person may submit either one entry, or both, a garment and a quilt. If you are unsure whether your item will qualify for the show, please ask.

For this exhibit, a "QUILT" consists of three layers—a designed top, center batting, and back—held together by stitched patterns or designs. This description pertains to both quilts and wearable art. We support all quilting styles: traditional, contemporary, and modern.

You will be required to attach Velcro (hook side) to the top of your quilt for hanging. Very large quilts will require additional Velcro on the bottom corners.

You can elect to sell your work; however, the Fairbanks Art Association will retain a 35% commission.

### **Quilt Alaska 2026 - Important Dates**

**Friday, May 1 – Friday, June 5** Enter your piece online at Fairbanks Arts Association. (You'll need to provide a photo of yourself along with a description of your quilt or garment.)

**Sunday, June 28** Intake at Bear Gallery – You will drop off your quilt at Bear Gallery. Your quilt and/or garment must remain on display throughout the entire show. (We will ask for volunteers to assist with intake and for the show set-up. We will share the exact times and dates as soon as the information becomes available.)

**Friday, July 3** First Friday at Bear Gallery - (We provide refreshments and will also need volunteers for the reception.)

**The quilt show will run from Friday, July 3 through Saturday, August 1**

**Sunday, August 2** Take down at Bear Gallery – You'll pick up your quilt at the gallery. (We will ask for volunteers for this day also.)
