## **Supply List & Cutting Instructions**

Lap 66" x 71"; (Full 83" x 92"); {Queen 99" x 113"}; [King 116" x 113"]



## **Supplies**

- Pattern: Sugar Sand Beach by Atkinson Designs will be available to purchase at class. I have 20.
- Creative Grids Spider Web ruler CGRKA6: I will have 15 available for purchase at class
- Fabric: Made with 2½" x 21" strips (jelly roll, scrappy or fat-quarter friendly) and yardage

Lap: 32 ( $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42") or 11 fat-quarters; background 4.5 yards (3.5 yd w/accent) (Full): 50 ( $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42") or 17 fat-quarters; background 7 yards (5.5 yd w/accent) (Queen): 72 ( $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42") or 24 fat-quarters; background 10 yards (8 yd w/accent) (King]: 83 ( $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42") or 28 fat-quarters; background 11.5 yards (9 yd w/accent)

Optional Accent color: 1% yard, (1% yard), {2.5 yd}, [3 yd]

• Other:

basic quilting supplies, rotary cutter with new blade, 24" rectangle ruler for cutting strips and background, optional: 12" square ruler for squaring up blocks, matching/blending thread.

## **Pre-cutting Instructions:**

- 1. Cut jelly roll strips in half on the fold.
- 2. If using scraps or fat-quarters cut six  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips from each fat-quarters or cut various strips to equal 64, (100), {144}, [166] fasbric
- 3. Background fabric:
  - a. Cut 4, (7), {10}, [12] strips 11¼" x 42"
  - b. Cut 3, (5), {8}, [9] strips 8½" x 42"
  - c. Cut 2, (4), {5}, [6] strips 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 42"
  - d. If using *background* as separator strips in diamonds:

```
Cut 22, (37), {56}, [65] strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 42" subcut these to make: 34, (58), {86}, [102] strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 21" and 12, (20), {30}, [35] strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 10" and 6, (12), {20}, [24} strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"
```

If using *accent* fabric as separator strips in diamonds:

```
Cut 22, (37), {56}, [65] strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 42" subcut these to make: 34, (58), {86}, [102] strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 21" and 12, (20), {30}, [35] strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 10" and 6, (12), {20}, [24] strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"; save remainder accent fabric for inner border. and cut 1, (2), {3}, [3] background strips 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x wof
```
