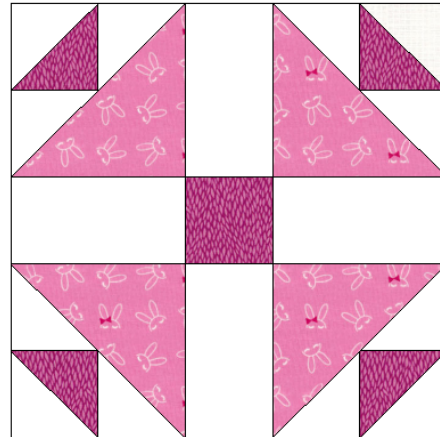
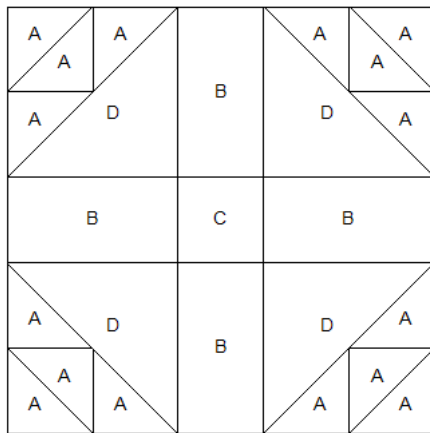


April Block of the Month

Duck and Ducklings



Brighten your day with this classic block!

Fabric and Cutting for One Block

Use spring colors, one color family for each block. Use three different fabrics for each block. The background is white or white on white, the middle square and the small triangles are a darker shade of the block color, and the large triangles are a medium shade of the block color.

A - 2 7/8" square, cut diagonally into half square triangles. (12 background and 4 spring color.)

B - 2 1/2" X 4 1/2". (4 background.)

C - 2 1/2" square. (1 spring color)

D - 4 7/8" square, cut diagonally into half square triangles. (2 spring color.)

Sewing

Sew the corner units together by first piecing the darker color with a background triangle to make a square, then sew the background triangles to that to make a larger triangle. Add the larger spring color triangle to make squares. Sew together as pictured.

Finished size is 10 inches, 10 1/2 inches unfinished.
