



Fabric and Cutting for One Block


Use red and green Christmas fabrics for the treetops. The trunks are brown. The background is white on white - <u>or</u> - a holiday fabric that reads white.






From the right side your blocks should appear as pictured in the colored diagram. Remember that the actual pattern is reversed.
