Quilted Notebook

Supply List

This project requires very few supplies. You will need to provide fabric, fusible fleece, fusible interfacing, thread to match. You'll be able to make two notebooks in two different sizes. I'll provide the notebooks, pens, and elastic needed to complete the project.

For large notebook cut fabric: 1 - 9" x 15" for front

1 - 9" x 15" for lining

1 - 9" x 15" for pocket

1 - 9" x 15" fusible fleece

1 - 4-1/2" x 15" fusible interfacing

For small notebook cut fabric: 1 - 6" x 10" for front

1 – 6" x 10" for lining

1 - 6" x 10" for pocket

1 - 6" x 10" fusible fleece

1 – 3" x 10" fusible interfacing

Iron fusible fleece to back of front fabric. Quilt.

Tack elastic to the top and bottom of the front fabric. 1-1/2" from the right side on the right side of the fabric. Make sure it isn't twisted.

Fold pocket fabric in half lengthwise wrong sides together. Iron fusible interfacing on the inside to one side of the folded fabric.

Top stitch along top edge of pocket approximately 1/8" from fold.

Match raw edge of pocket to bottom edge of lining fabric. Pin in place. Starting on right side, measure and mark 4" from the edge, 5" from the edge and 10-1/4" from the edge. Stitch on the lines. Reinforce at the top. This will form 3 pockets. The 4th pocket is the remainder to the edge of the left side.


Layer right sides together. Mark all four corners with a slight curve. *DO NOT trim curves until all layers are stitched together.

Stitch together, trim curves and turn inside out. Press and topstitch to close opening.

The instructions for the small quilted notebook are identical to the large notebook EXCEPT for:

- 1) The elastic is placed 1" from the right side when tacked to the front fabric.
- 2) The stitching to make the pockets. Starting at the right side, mark a line 2-3/4" from the right, 3-3/4" from the right and 7" from the right. The remainder will be the 4^{th} pocket.
