Proposed Bi-Law Changes

2025 BY-LAWS Proposed changes

Article III: Funding

2025

To obtain funds to further the above stated purposes, the corporation shall have the power to conduct fund raising activities and to accept contributions from individuals, foundations, and other organizations. It shall have the power to solicit and receive funds from the public for the purpose of the corporation, but no part of the net earnings, or any of the principals of this corporation shall insure the benefit of any Director, Member, or Members of the Corporation.

Under Article IV: Membership

Section 1: Membership shall be open to all persons interested in quilts and quilting who have paid annual dues. Dues shall be paid at or before the annual meeting and cover one year, November through next October. New members' dues shall be due upon entry into CFQG and new members joining after April 1 will have their dues pro-rated at 50%. Senior memberships (age 60+) are available at a 20% discount.

Article V: General Membership Meetings

Section 1: A meeting of the general membership shall be held the third Tuesday of each month, unless otherwise set by the Executive Board. The time and place of the meeting shall be announced at least one month in advance and published in the newsletter sent prior to that meeting. Part of these meetings may be devoted to business, and the business meetings shall be conducted according to parliamentary procedures as published in Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised whenever they are not inconsistent with these bylaws and any special rules of order the CFQG may adopt.

Recommend moving the section Article VII Committees to Order of Operation If section is not

moved, see highlighted corrections (proposed changes)

Article VII: Committees

Section 1: There shall be eighteen-nineteen standing committees: Publicity, Newsletter, Workshop, History, Nominating, Hospitality, Membership, Community Sewing, Fair, Quilt Alaska, Quilt Slushy, Snow Flurries, Quilting in the Snow, Google Groups Email List, Bazaars, Secret Pals, Sunshine Sue, and Raffle Chair. All committee chairs shall be appointed by the President and confirmed by the Executive Board.

Committee chairs shall report to the Executive Board, at the Board's discretion, may recruit volunteers or assistants as needed, and perform the following duties:

Proposed Bi-Law Changes Cont.

The Small Quilt Auction Chair shall:

- a. Be responsible for administering the Small Quilt Auction of the Tanana Valley Fair in a
- b. Work together with the Chair of Division 23-24 to ensure needs are covered.
- Be responsible for securing guilts to be auctioned.
- d. See that all small quilts are displayed properly and in an attractive manner.
- e. Determine winners of the auctioned items, the collection of funds, and getting monies to the CFQG Treasurer. Be responsible for distributing quilts to winners and communicating with quilt donors.
- f. Make a written report to the Executive Board upon completion of the event.

Propose "new" section

Article VII: Committee Chair

Section 1: All committee chairs shall be appointed by the President and confirmed by the Executive Board. Committee chairs shall report to the Executive Board, at the Board's discretion, may recruit volunteers or assistants as needed, and perform the following duties:

1. Prepare budget to present to the Executive Board for upcoming committees. Stay within proposed budget expenses and keep good receipts and records of any money spent. (Refer to Order of Operations for expectations and committee descriptions.)





September Block of The Month

September Block of the Month Maple Leaf





Welcome fall by sewing some pretty autumn leaves!

Fabric and Cutting for One Block

Use three fabrics. The leaves are autumn colors like gold, rust and orange. The background is cream. The stem is brown.

A-1" X4" rectangle. (1 brown)

B and D – 27/8" square, cut diagonally into half square triangles. (3 background and 2 leaf color)

C - 2 1/2" square. (1 background and 3 leaf color)

Sewing

For the stem-

Sew a background triangle to either side of the brown stem piece. Press to the background. Keeping the brown stem centered in the patch, trim to make a 2 ½" square. Use a 2 ½" ruler if you own one, or measure with the corner or any rotary ruler.


Sew the half square triangles together as pictured. Then piece the block together into a nine-patch.

Finished size is 6 inches, 6 ½ inches unfinished.

2025

*** Quilt Assembly**

Assemble and sew the 9 blocks, 16-21/2" green squares, and Assemble and sew the 9 blocks, 10-272 grant of all 24-16½" x 2½" white strips in rows as shown. Press toward the green squares and blocks. Join the rows.




Quilt is now 561/2" x 561/2" unfinished.






Mystery Quilt Page 2

Join 3-8½" x 4½" border red print 1 and 4-8½" x 4½" border red print 2 rectangles to make 1 side border. Make 2. Add to the quilt sides. Join 2-4½" border red print 1 squares, 3-8½" x 4½" border red print 1 and 4-8½" x 4½" border red print 2 rectangles to make 1 border. Make 2. Add to the top and bottom.



3 Add the 2½" x 64½" white strips to the quilt sides. Add the 2½" x 68½" white strips to the top and bottom. Layer, quilt and bind.
