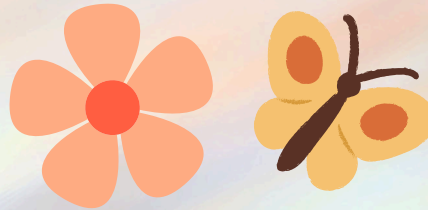

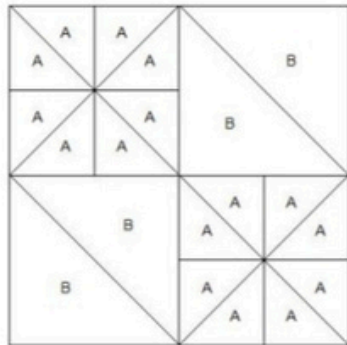

Block of the Month

May Block of the Month

Spinning Pinwheels



Fabric and Cutting

This block uses just three fabrics. Use fabrics that read red, white and black.

A – 2 7/8" squares, cut diagonally into half square triangles (8 red and 8 white) – or – Make 8 red and white half square triangle units using your favorite method.

B – 4 7/8" square, cut diagonally into a half square triangle. (2 black and two white) – or – Make 2 black and white half square triangle units using your favorite method.

Sewing

Make your half square triangle units and piece the pinwheels. Next, complete the block as pictured.

Finished size is 8 inches, 8 1/2 inches unfinished. Look at how great these simple blocks look when set together in a quilt top!



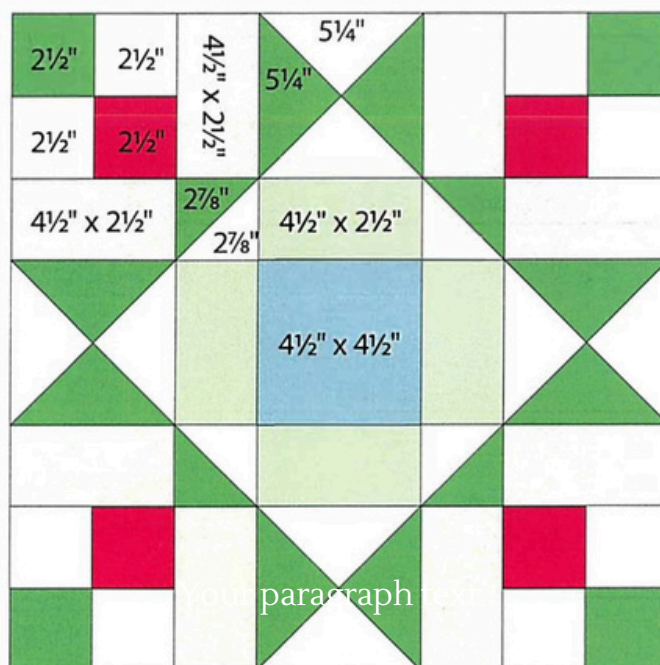

Month 4 - Block C

**Block C**

Make 2.

16" x 16" finished.

**Cutting for ONE block C****Red**

4-2 1/2" squares

Green2-5 1/4" squares, cut twice on the diagonal
to make 8 quarter square triangles2-2 7/8" squares, cut once on the diagonal
to make 4 half square triangles

4-2 1/2" squares

Blue: 1-4 1/2" square**Light Green:** 4-2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles*These pieces are cut on page 3:***White**

8-5 1/4" quarter square triangles

4-2 7/8" half square triangles

8-2 1/2" squares

Tan

8-2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

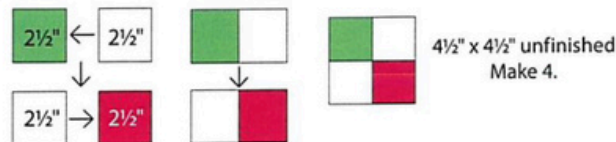

2025 Mystery Quilt

Month 4 - Block C

Construction Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams and press in the direction of the arrows.

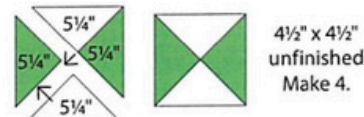
- 1 Join 1-2½" red, 1-2½" green, and 2-2½" white squares as shown. Make 4.



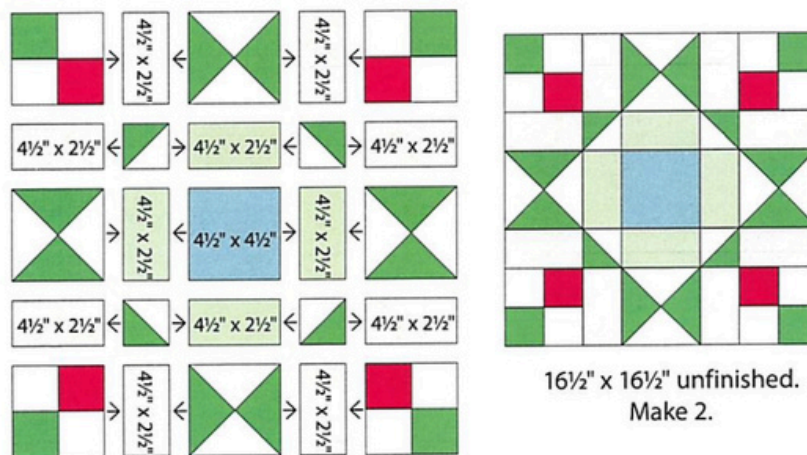
- 2 Join a 2⅞" green and a 2⅞" white half square triangle. Make 4.



- 3 Join a 2 white and 2 green 5¼" quarter square triangles. Make 4.



- 4 Arrange and sew the units from steps 1, 2, 3, 8-2½" x 4½" tan, 4-2½" x 4½" light green, and 1-4½" blue square in rows as shown. Join the rows. Repeat to make 2 blocks.

Small Quilt Auction Guidelines:

Size Range:

No smaller than 8" by 8"

No larger than 100" around

Consider other than square shapes, i.e. oval, triangle, etc.

Fabric:

Preprinted fabric giving the false impression of pieced work is not what we are looking for. Use your creativity when using your printed fabric especially if you are fussy cutting or using parts of the fabric in appliqué.

Quilting:

Whole cloth quilting that highlights special quilting, hand quilting, machine quilting as well as tying are all acceptable.

Quality of Work:

Care must be taken to present QUALITY workmanship. The committee head will assure that all entries are well done and labeled by the quiltmaker.
